CLASSROOM DEMONSTRATION

Panchsheel Vidhyalaya, one of the affordable schools in Vadodara, has been a valued partner in our educational mission for over four years. During regular classroom observations, our team identifies areas for improvement and provides targeted support.

One effective strategy has been our demonstration of **circle time** – a dynamic approach to foster inclusive discussions, emotional expression, and interactive learning. Through these sessions, we aim to create a safe space where students feel heard and engaged, empowering teachers to connect with students on a deeper level and nurture a positive classroom culture.

TRAINING ON LANGUAGE OF NUMBERS - 3E

As a follow-up to our recent Wipro workshop, we organized a Teaching Learning Circle with Anganwadi workers from five model centers on the Language of Numbers. This session equipped early educators with engaging techniques to introduce foundational number concepts, helping young learners develop counting skills, number recognition, and basic math understanding. Through this initiative, we aim to build a strong numerical foundation, inspiring curiosity and comprehension in early numeracy.

WORKSHOP - LARGE SCALE

We recently conducted a training program for **314 Anganwadi workers**, providing essential knowledge on brain development in children aged 3 to 5 years. The sessions highlighted the critical role of early stimulation, activity-based learning, and effective classroom management in supporting growth during these formative years. Additionally, the training focused on the five interconnected developmental domains, equipping educators with practical strategies for holistic child engagement. This initiative represents a vital step in enhancing early childhood education, laying a strong foundation for lifelong development in young learners. education in our region.

TRAINING ON LEARNING CORNER - LARGE SCALE

completed training with Anganwadi workers from the North Zone on establishing **Learning Corners**, known within the ICDS setup as **Char Khuna ni Ramat**. The training introduced the concept of Learning Corners and highlighted how these spaces support the development of various domains and essential skills in early childhood. Anganwadi workers were also guided on how to engage children effectively within these corners, encouraging exploration and growth through structured play. 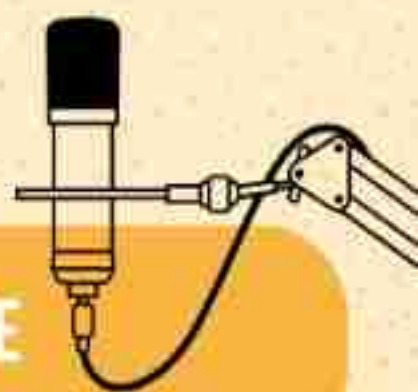
